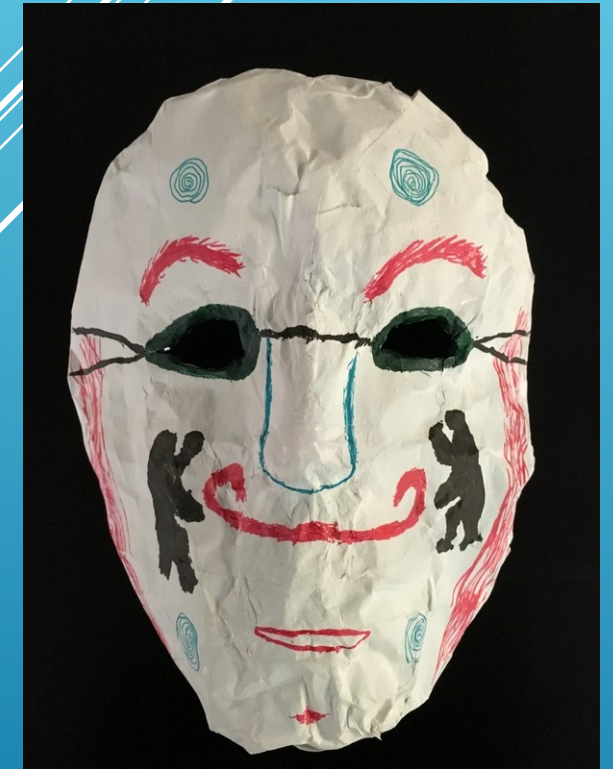

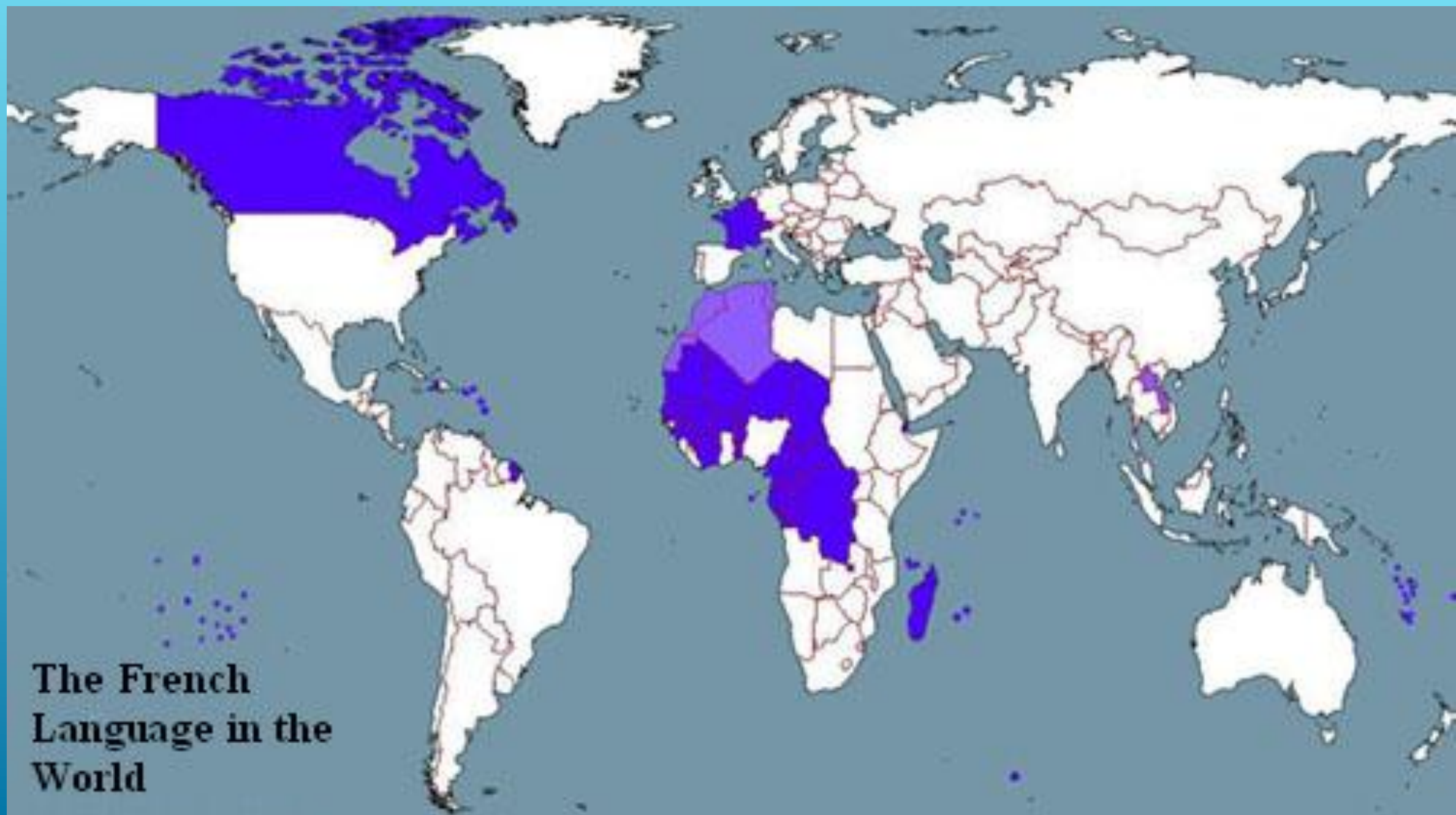

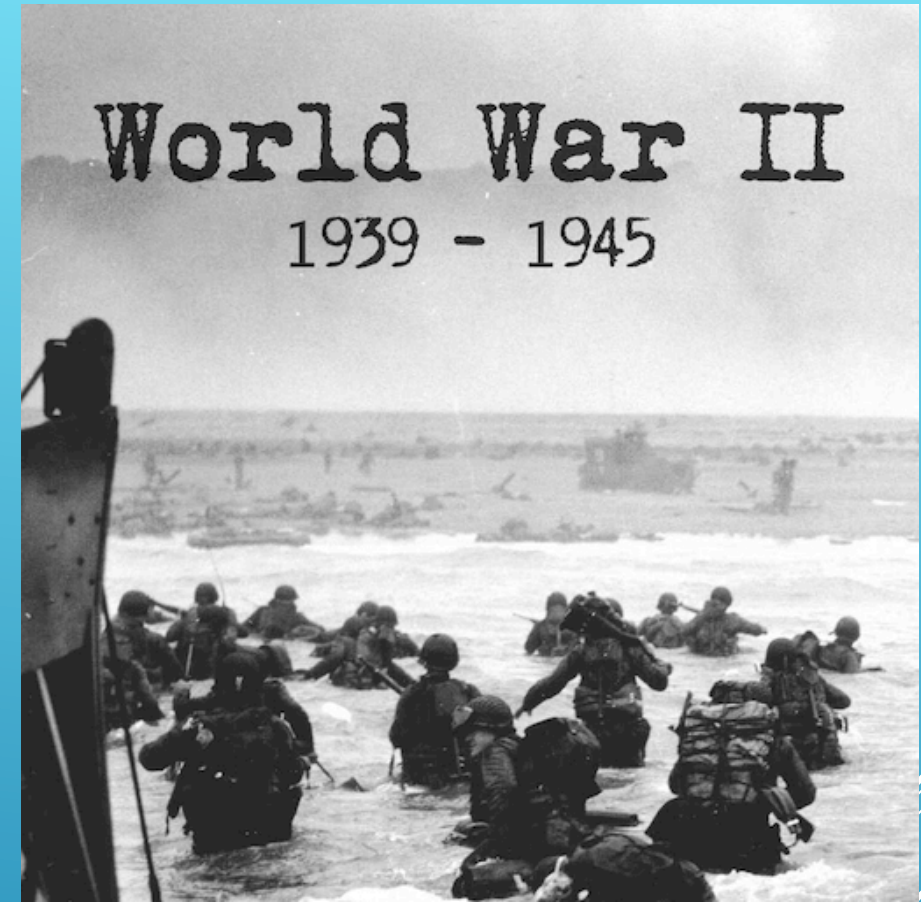

THROUGH HISTORY

- ▶ French explorer Jacques Cartier claims territories in 1534- explores the Saint Lawrence river and the French establish fur trading posts
- ▶ In the 1600s French exploration continues along the Great Lakes and the Mississippi Valley. The Explorer La Salle takes the colony of Louisiana for France in 1682
- ▶ 1685-1755 The Huguenots (French Protestants) form communities in North America French Acadians leave Nova Scotia and settle in New England and Louisiana when forced out by the British



1803 The United States purchases Louisiana

She became famous when she ferried General Lafayette to the United States in 1780 for support to the Americans in the American Revolutionary War

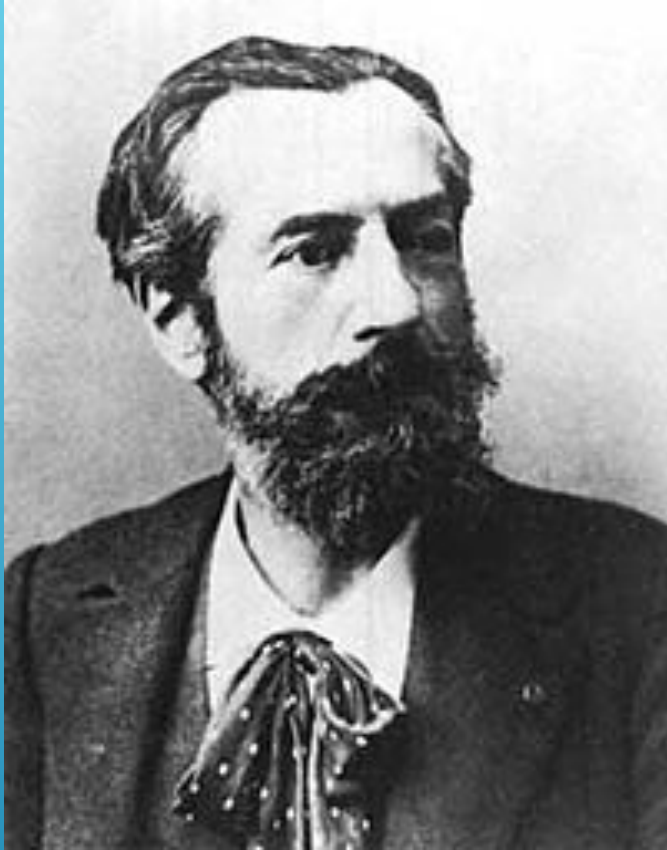

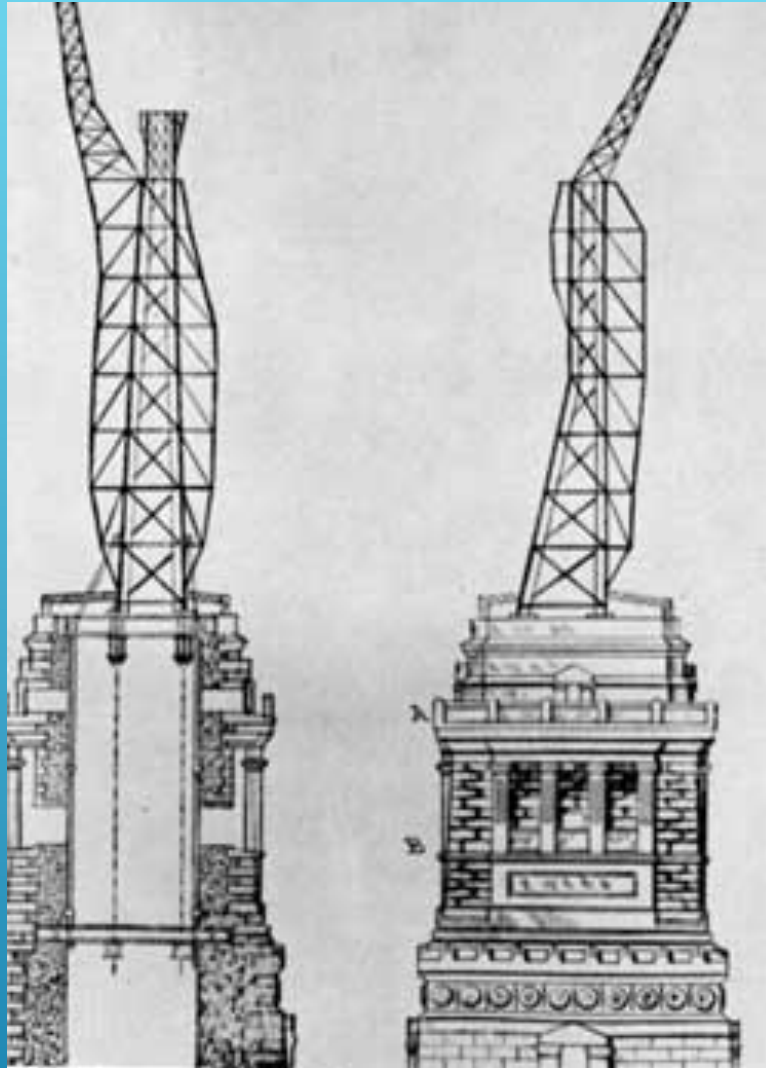
